Admission and commencement of trading of the 43,478,478 new, common, dematerialized, registered, voting shares, of a nominal value of €0.30 each of "Aktor Societe Anonyme Holding Company Technical and Energy Projects", issued pursuant to the share capital increase through payment in cash with pre-emptive rights in favour of the existing shareholders

The Company under the name "Aktor Societe Anonyme Holding Company Technical and Energy Projects" (hereinafter "the Company") announces that:

- (a) The Athens Exchange on 31.01.2025 approved the admission to trading of the forty-three million four hundred seventy eight thousand four hundred and seventy eight (43,478,478) new, common, dematerialized, registered, voting shares of the Company, each of a nominal value of thirty euro cents (€0.30) (the "New Shares"), resulting from the Share Capital Increase through payment in cash with pre-emptive rights in favour of the existing shareholders (the "Share Capital Increase"), as per the resolution of the Extraordinary General Meeting of the Shareholders of the Company, during its meeting held on 19.11.2024, and
- (b) The commencement of trading of the New Shares on the Main Market of the Athens Exchange (regulated market under Law 4514/2018) is expected on **04.02.2025**.

The New Shares will have been credited to the shares and the securities accounts of the beneficiaries, which are held in the Dematerialized Securities System (D.S.S.), on the day of commencement of their trading.

The total funds raised through the Share Capital Increase amount to two hundred million nine hundred and ninety eight euro and eighty euro cents (€200,000,998.80) and, following the deduction of the estimated expenses of approximately €2 million, will be allocated in accordance with section "4.1.2 Reasons for the Share Capital Increase and Use of Proceeds" of the Company's Prospectus, which was approved by the Board of Directors of the Hellenic Capital Market Commission at its meeting held on 27.12.2024.
